Curricular Area	Topic / Theme
Literacy and English	 Class book – Reading – Accelerated Reading (AR) own choice books and Story world reading scheme. Grammar – Spelling – Weekly words given on a Monday for test on Friday. Comprehension – Blue Box, Reading Comprehension, Reading for Meaning Writing – Talk for Writing (fiction), Topic writing (non-fiction) Outdoor Literacy – Improving descriptive vocabulary using the senses.
Maths and Numeracy	Number work including times tables.Fractions.
Sciences	 Forces on toys and other objects, magnets, forces and a game, sound from vibrations
Technologies	 ICT – Using a search engine (e.g. Google) to research facts and information. Using Sumdog App to develop Numeracy and Maths ability. Using the iPad to photograph/record their learning across different curricular areas.
Social Studies	Viking topic, looking at travel, longboats, clothing, how they lived, longhouses.
Expressive Arts	 Art – Topic related. Drama – Topic related play writing and puppet shows. Music – Working with Mrs McInnes (Music Specialist)
Health and Wellbeing	 PATHS Anti-Bullying and making/maintaining relationships. Daily walk. PE – Team games, co-operation
Modern Languages	 Revision of basic introductions. Numbers. Days of week and month. France
Homework	 Spelling – Practice words for test on Friday Reading – Please encourage your child to read a book each night. Maths - Practise times tables – please encourage your child to practise this every night.
